Program or project description	54 reasons operates independent units of accommodation, located within secure facilities, and outreach support to women and children escaping domestic and family violence. In these environments women and children can feel safe and will receive the support and information they need to make informed choices about their future, free from the immediate threat of violence. 54 reasons works within a human and child rights and a child participatory approach. Our parent and child support practitioners operate within a practice framework that is child and women centered and trauma informed. Children are treated as individuals in their own right. Our accommodation and outreach programs are located in various regions of South Queensland. Our staff to assist individuals overcome the impact of having experienced DFV, providing case management support to women and their children. They strive to fulfil the service agreement between 54 reasons and the Department of Communities. This is achieved by adhering to the mission of 54 reasons, the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child and the practice framework of the organisation to work within a supported accommodation assistance program in refuge, and through the provision of outreach support for individuals where a refuge response is not the best option for their situation.
