Program or project description	<p>Since 2017, 54 reasons has been part of an integrated service response model to meet the safety needs of people experiencing Domestic and Family Violence in Mount Isa and the Gulf region. The Mount Isa and Gulf Domestic and Family Violence Specialist Service is part of the broader service system that works with people (and their children) who have experienced or are at risk of experiencing domestic and family violence. The aim of the support provided is to increase safety and reduce the use or incidents of domestic and family violence that impact children, individuals and families. Support is provided through individualised case management support, court based support in some communities and Community Education initiatives.</p> <p>Specifically, we provide:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Supports during business hours for aggrieved individuals including adults and their children, young people• Supports after hours for aggrieved individuals including adults and their children, young people through a Mt Isa specific After Hours response - MIAH• Community education and awareness sessions• System Support – Local Domestic and Family Violence Service Systems (HRT)
