The service includes an Early Childhood Coordination component which runs alongside our integrated model of support for families. We focus on three types of tailored support following a robust intake and assessment process, backed by a dedicated Service Coordinator to ensure that the Early Years Place is integrated within the community: • Age-appropriate group programs through supported playgroups (children aged 0-5) and psychosocial support through the Journey of Hope program (children aged 5-8) • Case Management and Therapeutic Family Support with goal setting and 1-1 parent coaching • Group parent education workshops including Bringing Up Great Kids and Circle of Security. The Early Years Place aims to achieve the following outcomes aligned to the Integrated Service Delivery framework: • Increased caregiver awareness and engagement with their child's learning, wellbeing and development • Increased secure attachment between children and their caregivers • Increased parental capabilities and confidence in parenting selfeficacy • Improvement in the rate of children developmentally on track • Increased connection for families to local services at the right time, including kindergarten • Increased access to a range of programs that meet the diverse needs
