Support is targeted specifically at families who have been identified and assessed by CSS as ready for family restoration. The service works closely with parents, children and young people to build family capacity and support the safe and sustainable restoration of families by providing targeted, transparent, and explicit support and ensuring the voice of children and youth is heard at all levels. Those working in the service also work closely with other key stakeholders including Child Safety Services (CSS), to overcome personal and/or environmental barriers to children's safety and build the strength, capacity and protections required for families to provide a consistent, safe, and nurturing home environment for their children. The service aims to build family capacity by modelling direct contact with children utilising a range of evidence-based parenting programs to support parents to understand how these programs can be utilised. We use
