Program or project description	<p>Play2Learn+ (P2L+) is an early childhood readiness program which aims to improve child development and wellbeing by building the skills of parents and guardians to further the educational attainment of the children in their care.</p> <p>P2L+ creates material differences in the life trajectory of children at risk by supporting them to be on track at two key transitions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. early childhood education engagement2. kindergarten (school readiness at school commencement) <p>P2L+ works with families experiencing social disadvantage with three and four year old children due to enter school in the following year, who are not attending or regularly accessing early childhood education services. All participation in P2L+ is voluntary.</p>
