Program or project description	54 reasons has operated a kindergarten in Mooroopna since 1969, with 3 year old and 4 year old classes. The kindergarten is not a 'mainstream' service – it is free for families, and caters to families with one or more attributes we regard as creating vulnerability in families and their children. These are: • 'At risk' children and families, including children at risk of abuse or neglect through domestic violence, drug and alcohol abuse, mental health issues or other disadvantage • Families known to child protection services • Families experiencing problems with housing • Families experiencing social and economic barriers to participation • Socially isolated families, or families experiencing locational disadvantage in rural and remote areas • Families in transition, including pregnancy, birth and infancy, family, health, education, housing and legal transitions Staff at the kindergarten work within a culturally inclusive and holistic model of early childhood education and family/parenting support, while also building and maintaining connections with other service providers externally. A bus service is provided to assist families with pick up and drop-off, and our staff connect families to additional services where required.
