Program or project description	 Armadale West is one of four communities working within the Early Years Partnership (EYP). The EYP is aimed at improving the wellbeing and school readiness of children pre-conception to four years of age, as part of the implementation of the Armadale West Early Years Community Plan. The Armadale West partnership (local working group) is a collective of community representatives from a variety of organisations that ensures local knowledge, community engagement and ownership of solutions and opportunities for the area. The group includes representatives from the Department of Communities, 54 reasons, City of Armadale, Department of Health, Minderoo Foundation, and other identified local stakeholders. The EYP has four main aims: Increase access to early years services and programs to improve child development outcomes and school readiness Increase engagement in child health checks Increase collaboration between early years services and programs Improve service system/service provider understanding about parent's direct experience with the early years system and the barriers they experience
