The program works closely with the support services for parents/carers and children where there are multiple issues that impact on family functioning. The program utilises evidence-based tools that include Bringing up Great Kids and takes a strength based, trauma informed approach, developing individual case plans with families to set measurable goals. The program also aims to facilitate access to services and enhance parents' capacity to support the development of their child.
