Role Purpose

The Agile Project Coordinator is responsible for supporting the successful delivery of initiatives within Save the Children Australia's Supporter Engagement portfolio. Reporting to the Head of Strategy and Projects, this role will play an active part in a range of small and large scale projects in a fast-paced and innovative environment.

A key focus initiative for the role will be the evolution of our national retail network, including the roll out of our volunteer application, multiple process improvements and expansion through the addition of new large-format stores across Australia.

A results-driven person and creative problem solver, the Agile Project Coordinator will have the ability to manage multiple initiatives across different teams and with varied stakeholders. They will engage in projects from beginning to end - from understanding the requirements and helping define solutions, to driving implementation in line with the project timeline.

Successfully coordinate and support projects and initiatives within the fundraising and retail portfolios, including:

- Working with team members to plan out project tasks and create a roadmap (timeline) for delivery
- Driving and monitoring delivery in line with the agreed roadmap
- Identifying and flagging potential risks, issues, scheduling conflicts
- Coordinating and facilitating project team meetings including planning sessions, stand ups and reviews
- Communicating project progress by providing updates and reports to stakeholders, clearly calling out successes, risks and changes
- Assisting with the development of outlines, rationales and business cases
- Gathering and consolidating background information and requirements using collaborative workshops or written briefs
- Assisting with the investigation into solutions and opportunities, considering risks, benefits and business impacts
- Modelling adherence to the tools and processes of our agile project framework
